

Craftsmanship since 1919

With more than 100 years of experience in craftsmanship, we manufacture the furniture in Denmark at our own workshop in the city of Vejen.

Ergonomic designs

Our furniture is developed in close collaboration with occupational therapists, physiotherapists, and leading Danish designers.

Customization

As every piece is made-to-order, we offer great flexibility, accommodating individual desires for customizations and additions.

Responsibility and quality

Responsible production is at the core of the company. All pieces are made in certified European solid oak or beech and is crafted using traditional techniques, ensuring the highest quality and prolonged lifespan.

Each chair is assembled with water-based glue, dowels, double tenons, and finger joints. No screws are used, eliminating the need for subsequent tightening.

The furniture can withstand heavy usage, and a 5-year warranty is provided on all wooden frames.

About the 6000 series:

The 6000 Series holds a clean and simple design rooted in the rich tradition of Danish craftsmanship. Comprising two chairs, a footrest, and two resting chairs, the series is specifically crafted for the contract market, tailored particularly for institutional and public settings such as hospitals, nursing homes, and churches.

Exceptionally stable, this series offers a high level of user support and excellent seating comfort, ensuring steadiness when transitioning to a standing position. The chairs remain sturdy even when leaned upon, with no risk of tipping, and the stackable design adds to their practicality.

The frame is meticulously assembled using dowels, double tenons, and water-based glue, eliminating the need for subsequent tightening while clean lines and minimal stitching ensure optimal hygiene and easy maintenance. The series also offer a range of customizable features such as linking, castors and upholstery options specifically designed for the care sector.

Crafted at our workshop in Vejen, the series is available in certified solid beech or oak upholstered in textile or leather.

The series has been tested and approved by the Danish Technological Institute for stability, safety, and durability.
