Craftsmanship since 1919

With more than 100 years of experience in craftsmanship, we manufacture the furniture in Denmark at our own workshop in the city of Vejen.

Ergonomic designs

Our furniture is developed in close collaboration with occupational therapists, physiotherapists, and leading Danish designers.

Customization

As every piece is made-to-order, we offer great flexibility, accommodating individual desires for customizations and additions.

Responsibility and quality

Responsible production is at the core of the company. All pieces are made in certified European solid oak or beech and is crafted using traditional techniques, ensuring the highest quality and prolonged lifespan.

Each chair is assembled with water-based glue, dowels, double tenons, and finger joints. No screws are used, eliminating the need for subsequent tightening.

The furniture can withstand heavy usage, and a 5-year warranty is provided on all wooden frames.

The Ono Series

Ono SVF features gliding brackets, allowing the backrest to smoothly tilt backward and the seat to slide forward. The adjustment is seamless and responds to the user's weight.

The gliding brackets can be securely locked in any position. While the seat angle remains constant, tilting the back backwards creates a wider side angle for enhanced comfort.

About the Ono series:

The series comprises a range of sturdy and ergonomically correct models with various features, designed by Friis & Moltke. Each chair is carefully proportioned to ensure a harmonious balance between comfort, design, and functional requirements.

Furthermore, the series is extremely stable, offering excellent user support and seating comfort. The chairs remain steady during use and when leaned upon, without the risk of tipping. The light, Nordic design with clean lines and minimal seams ensures optimal hygiene.

The series is available in certified oak or beech, with a variety of optional features. Ono SVF is available with elegantly crafted walnut armrest. The series is manufactured at our workshop in Vejen, Denmark.

Tested and approved by the Danish Technological Institute for stability, safety, and durability. The following models hold Möbelfakta certification: Ono-SVF, Ono-SV, Ono-SJ, Ono-L.

Nygaard Nursing Home includes a 'dementia village' and consists of both new construction and rehabilitation on the site of the existing Sandefjord Nursing Home. The new nursing home section caters to 72 people with dementia, while the entire facility offers accommodation for a total of 180 residents. The new building was completed in March 2022 and it built in solid wood.
