Responsibility
and quality

Responsible production is at the core of the company. All pieces are made in certified European solid oak or beech and is crafted using traditional techniques, ensuring the highest quality and prolonged lifespan.

Each chair is assembled with water-based glue, dowels, double tenons, and finger joints. No screws are used, eliminating the need for subsequent tightening.

The furniture can withstand heavy usage, and a 5-year warranty is provided on all wooden frames.

About the Iko Series:

Iko is a simple and versatile bench designed by Friis & Moltke in 2022. With its minimalist silhouette and fine, subtle details, the design has a modern and classic expression that fits seamlessly into a wide range of interiors. Developed for the contract market, the bench is particularly suitable for cultural institutions like church spaces, offering users comfort and support.

The simple yet sturdy construction in solid wood ensures durability and adds stability without compromising its lightweight expression. Crafted at our workshop in Vejen, Denmark, following the proud Danish craftsmanship traditions, the frame of the bench is joined using dowels and water-based glue, eliminating the need for subsequent tightening.

The Iko Bench comes in two lengths, and is crafted from certified beech or oak, available with or without upholstery on the seat.

A Space for Diversity and Contemplation at Hvinningdal Church

Hvinningdal Church is situated on top of a hill, serving as a landmark in the open green landscape. The church is designed as a single-story angular building that forms two distinct spaces – a sheltered, southeast-facing arrival square that embraces “the near,” and a viewpoint square that faces towards the horizon, capturing “the distant,” providing room for contemplation and reflection. The open facades face the arrival square, inviting visitors inside into an open foyer that connects the building’s functions.

The church was designed by Friis & Moltke in collaboration with Hamiconsult and Lytt and is furnished with the Iko Bench and the Mio Chair.
